## English

Complete the tasks in the Phase 5 Tricky Word Activity Booklet.

Read a book of your choice at home. Retell the story in your own words. What was your favourite part? Which character did you like best and why?

Read and complete the questions on the 60 second read worksheets.

Google ICT Games. Click English games. Play the following games:

- Spooky Spellings
- Tell a T Rex (Choose a sound your child is familiar with)
- Poop Deck Pirates (Choose Phase 3 and 2 sounds your child is familiar with)
- Forest Phonics (Choose a sound your child is familiar with)

Use adjectives on the Describe the Creature worksheet.

Write a letter to your friends at school. What would you like to tell them? Could you ask them a question?

## Please note

You do not have to complete all of these tasks. Please do whatever you feel you are able to. You can post some pictures of what you have been doing at home on Seesaw too.

## Maths

Go on a shape hunt in your house. Look for 3D shapes. What faces do they have? How many vertices do they have? What about the edges?

Use the numicon worksheet cut out the numicon tiles. Can you use them to write your own addition and subtraction number sentences?

Play the Missing Numbers game using the worksheet.

Google ICT Games. Click Maths games. Play the following games:

- Whack a mole (Choose either steps of 1, 2, 5 or 10, choose counting forwards or backwards)
- Post a Letter (Choose a range of numbers appropriate for your child)
- Smoothie Maths (Choose facts to make 10)
- Save the Whale

Using some kitchen scales weigh 5 items in your house. Place them in order from the heaviest to the lightest.

Using a ruler or a tape measure, measure some items in your home in cm. Place them in order from the longest to the shortest. Find something else that is shorter than the shortest item and longer than the longest item.

Practise writing your numbers. You could do this in sand, glitter paint, pens or water with a paintbrush outside.

## Foundation

Ask your adult for a potato. Can you decorate it to look like a superhero. Look up Supertato on Google for inspiration.

Design a superhero cape. Use materials that would protect your Superhero. What special powers or features would the cape have?

Research your favourite animal. Write a fact file about it. What do they eat? Where do they live? How are they adapted to live in their environment?

Listen to a classical piece of music. On a piece of paper, draw and colour what the music makes you feel.
