COVID-19 REMINDERS

It is essential that you must inform school leaders if your child or anyone in the household develops COVID-19 symptoms. Please follow government advice regarding isolating measures to reduce the risk of transmission.

If you have any concerns about your child/ren or they are displaying symptoms of stress or anxiety, please contact Mrs Powell at the school who is our named member of staff for all COVID-19 related queries and follow Public Health England (PHE) advice.

- When dropping off your child at the Susan the Dragon gate there is no need to cross the road with your child. Mr Smith and I are on duty to safely see the children across the road and it is very important that adults remain on the other side of the road away from the class.
- Please refrain from lingering on the other side of the road, especially in groups as this is not respecting any form of social distancing. When you have dropped off or collected your child there is no need to wait, please leave the area opposite the school immediately. (Mrs Pinkney is on the playground on a daily basis to ensure that the children get to their class safely.)
- When dropping off a child at the main gate, please observe and respect appropriate social distancing maintain an appropriate gap in-between each family.
- We ask that all parents and carers respect the queuing system by joining the end of the line. (New social distancing signs have been added outside)
- Due to the significant increase in COVID cases, we would request all adults, especially when lining up outside the main gate at drop off and collection times to wear a face covering please. Whilst we cannot enforce this we would highly recommend it at this current time.
- On the occasions where you are invited onto school premises, by a senior member of staff, you will be expected to wear a face covering.

PARENT COMMUNICATION WITH SCHOOL STAFF

I can only hope that we will be able to allow you all back onto our school premises at some point before the end of the academic year.

Please make every effort to refrain from parking in the designated areas which include;

- Anywhere on the yellow zig-zag lines which includes dropping off and collecting.
- The bends on either side of our school car-park.
- Across the dropped kerb opposite the main school gates which is the only safe place for pedestrians to cross.
- Directly opposite the school on either side of the bend that leads to a residential carparking area.
- Opposite the school field on the bend on Juniper Road as this obstructs through traffic.
- Across the entrance / driveway of any local residents' properties.


