








### CHESS HOMELESSNESS ASSEMBLY

### LATENESS PARENTS REMINDER

This week we have had many parents/carers bringing their children into school late. It is very important for the children's education that they arrive on time to school on a daily basis and are encouraged from an early age by their parents about the importance of being on time, especially in readiness for transition to High School.

Class teachers open their doors at 8:45am and children are expected to be in class completing spelling or handwriting tasks at their desks by no later than 8:50am. Any children arriving after this time will need to enter the school via the school office to sign in using the lateness record book.

Parents who bring their children persistently late into school without a valid reason could become subject to a referral to the Local Authority School Attendance Team.
