<p>Write an explanation text explaining why the heart is important in the body. Challenge - can you use colons/ semi-colons/ hyphens/ dashes?</p>	<p>Write 20 balancing calculations using a range of operations. i.e. <math>3 \times 8 = 48 \div 2</math> Challenge yourself to use BODMAS.</p>	<p>Write a play <b>OR</b> draw a cartoon strip. The story should be about a group of friends who have a friendship problem, but manage to solve it somehow.</p>
<p>Write a setting description of your favourite place. Remember to include as much detail as possible and use all your senses.
