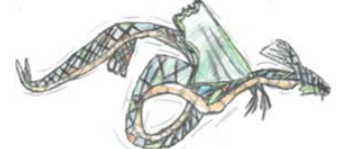
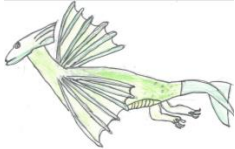

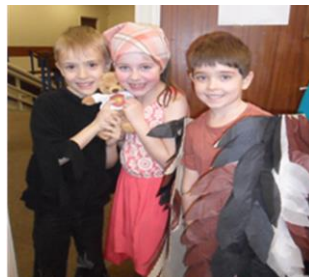

Liz was a loyal supporter and true friend of the school, from protesting as a parent outside the offices of the local authority to being a member of our recent Save Our Susan committee. She was a much-loved adopted grandma to more than one family in our school and supported all our events to the end, even coming to our Christmas production in December when she was exceptionally poorly. To commemorate our appreciation of Liz and all she did for us, we awarded the Annual Liz Bower Award for Determination for the first time at our Leavers Assembly this year.
