Dogs on Site Policy

School Vision

Boreham Primary School is a village school with over 200 children on-roll. We pride ourselves on working together with parents and children to ensure a happy learning relationship for all pupils.

Our governors, staff and pupils make Boreham Primary School a pleasure to be part of, with shared principles of friendship, trust and mutual respect leading to high achievement.

At Boreham Primary School we undertake to comply with all regulations in regard to Child Protection and safeguarding duties. We comply with all regulations as set down by the LA, DfE and Health and Safety Codes of Practice.

The Governing Body of Boreham School agreed the following statements in creating a 'dogs on site' policy for the school:

Boreham School is a **No** Dogs School.

No dogs (other than dogs for the disabled) are allowed at any time within the buildings or on school site.

Parents, pupils, visitors and staff must not bring dogs onto the school site at any time or tie them up outside any of the school gates or perimeter fencing unattended.

Monitoring & Review

The Governing Body will review this policy on a two year cycle.
