Design a Norman meal. It could be fun to have a go at making a recipe or two!! Take pictures of you making it or bring some into school for us to taste.	
Create an imaginary recount of you invading another land. Remember to include key features of a recount!		See Mr Bishop to get some reasoning and problem solving questions!		Design a board game. How many players can play? What is the purpose of the game and how do you win?	
<b>Challenge activity</b> Write a newspaper report about King Harold taking the throne from the perspective of the Anglo Saxon Chronicle! Remember to include the reasons for him taking the throne.		<b>Challenge activity</b> Come up with some word problems of your own and give them to a friend in class. Get them back and mark them then hand it in!		<b>Challenge activity</b> Identify locations of Norman Settlement on a map.
