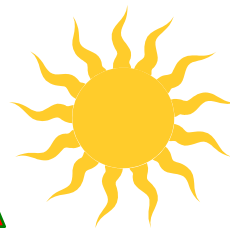

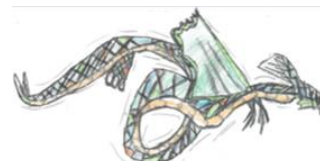
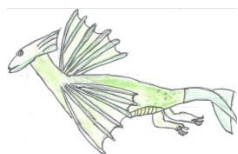

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of the new 'grab and go' cold lunch that will be on offer too. Finally, lemon and courgette cake or chocolate beetroot cake were also served.



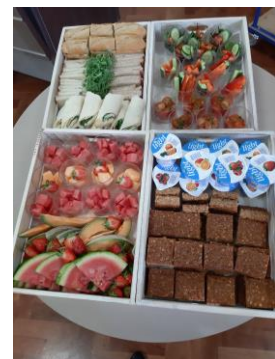
