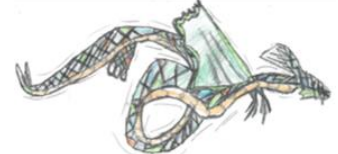
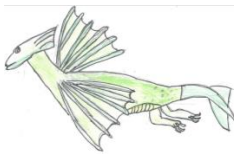

SCHOOL SWIMMING POOL UPDATE

This week, our classes have been talking about what they would like to replace our outdoor swimming pool with. Mr Smith has started the process of clearing the current site and in September we will begin a massive fundraising campaign to raise funds for our replacement project. We will also be applying for any available grants too.

Ms Stephens has been working very hard behind the scenes to secure swimming lessons for our new Years 3-6 pupils at Witham Leisure Centre from September. Our intention is to start with our new Year 5 cohort for 10 sessions during the Autumn term. More details to follow soon.

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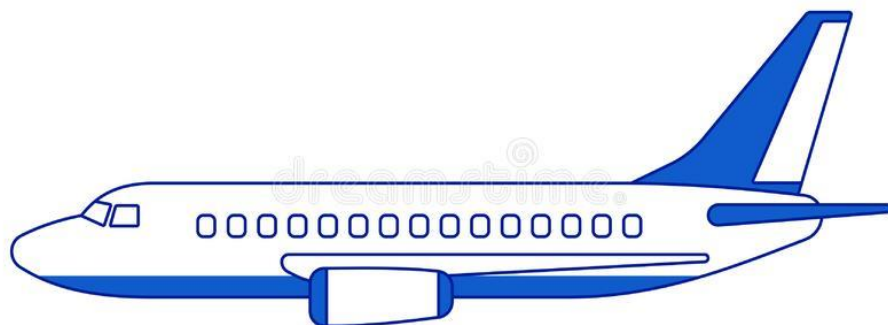
